THE CIVIL WARS IN C19 PORTUGAL

The marriage in 1785 of D João (the future D João VI of Portugal) to the Infanta D Carlota Joaquina of Spain was personally unhappy for both of them. It also brought unhappiness in its wake for Portugal in the shape of a civil war, as Dowager Queen Carlota supported her favourite younger son D Miguel against the rightful heir D Pedro. Portugal had suffered immensely during the three Napoleonic invasions and for six years 1828 - 1834 this small country was ravaged again but this time by civil war. In the Algarve, Tavira was solidly behind the usurper, and the outcome for some Tavirenses was bloody massacre. Looking at our peaceful and charming town today, who would believe it?
