FAMOUS ALGARVEANS

There are Algarveans who are famous in Portuguese history for success, and one or two are famous in the Algarve for failure. Perhaps many people could name two Algarveans who have been President of the Republic (Teixeira Gomes and Cavaco Silva). but might be challenged to name the third. Joaquim Lopes Portugal's first lifeboatman and lifesaver was from Olhão, and Duarte Pacheco from Loulé had an immense influence on the built environment of the country in the mid twentieth century. As for the failures, the civil wars of the 1830s were vicious, and fatal for those (such as Sebastião Martins and Remexido) ultimately on the wrong side. António Aleixo sits proudly at his table outside the Calcinha in Loulé, slowly dying of tuberculosis. Who are these people and why are they famous? TALK ON THE RESTORA-TION OF 1640

December 1st has been a public holiday in Portugal for some years. Why and what does it commemorate? After 60 years of rule by the King of Spain, the Portuguese became anxious to take their government into their own hands again. On December 1st in Lisbon, the Spanish vicereine was dispossessed and her Portuguese factotum was defenestrated. Later on December 15th the conspirators acclaimed the Duke of Bragança as D João IV. Should we continue to remember these events? Peter Booker celebrates the reassertion of Portuguese national identity. The event will be held in Pessoa's Café on the left bank of the River Gilão in Tavira. Café owners Peter Dost and Paula Ferreira will have on sale a variety of tapas using local produce and Portuguese wines. THE GEOLOGY OF THE AL-GARVE

Ludo Broothaers is a geologist with a Ph.D. degree from the University of Leuven, Belgium. His career includes prospecting for base metals, setting up mineralogical laboratories and lecturing at a school for mining engineers. He has spend much of his career overseas in Morocco, Indonesia and Surinam. He has also worked for the Flemish Government.

Ludo's lecture is aimed at the lay person and as an introduction he will explain some of the basic principles of geology. He will then give a general outline of the geology of the Algarve, describing the composition and origins of local rock formations in the context of their geological date. He will make comparisons with similar rocks and geological eras in the UK.
