PERKIN WARBECK AND PORTUGAL

Perkin Warbeck is the most famous Pretender in English history. In the 1490s, he toured the courts of Europe claiming to be Richard Duke of York, one of the Princes in the Tower, and therefore rightful King of England. It is not widely known that his career probably began in Portugal, and this talk investigates Perkin's little-known connections with England's oldest ally, and introduces the lives and careers of some extraordinary Portuguese with whom Perkin was associated.
