Of all the Queens of Great Britain, Catherine is one of the least well known by the general public in her adopted country. There are no modern biographies of Catherine, and fictional works concentrate on Charles II's relationships with his many mistresses rather than on his undoubted, if unfaithful, love for Catherine. This talk will describe her life before marriage, her time as Queen and include the time in after Charles's death both in England and her important contribution to the well-being of her native land after her return to Portugal.

The talk will be illustrated with pictures from the period which include Charles's mistresses. The talk will also convey some of the unique atmosphere of both the Restoration court, with its fashion, its scurrilous gossip and its politics, and the perilous state of Portugal as she sought allies in the Restoration War with Spain.
